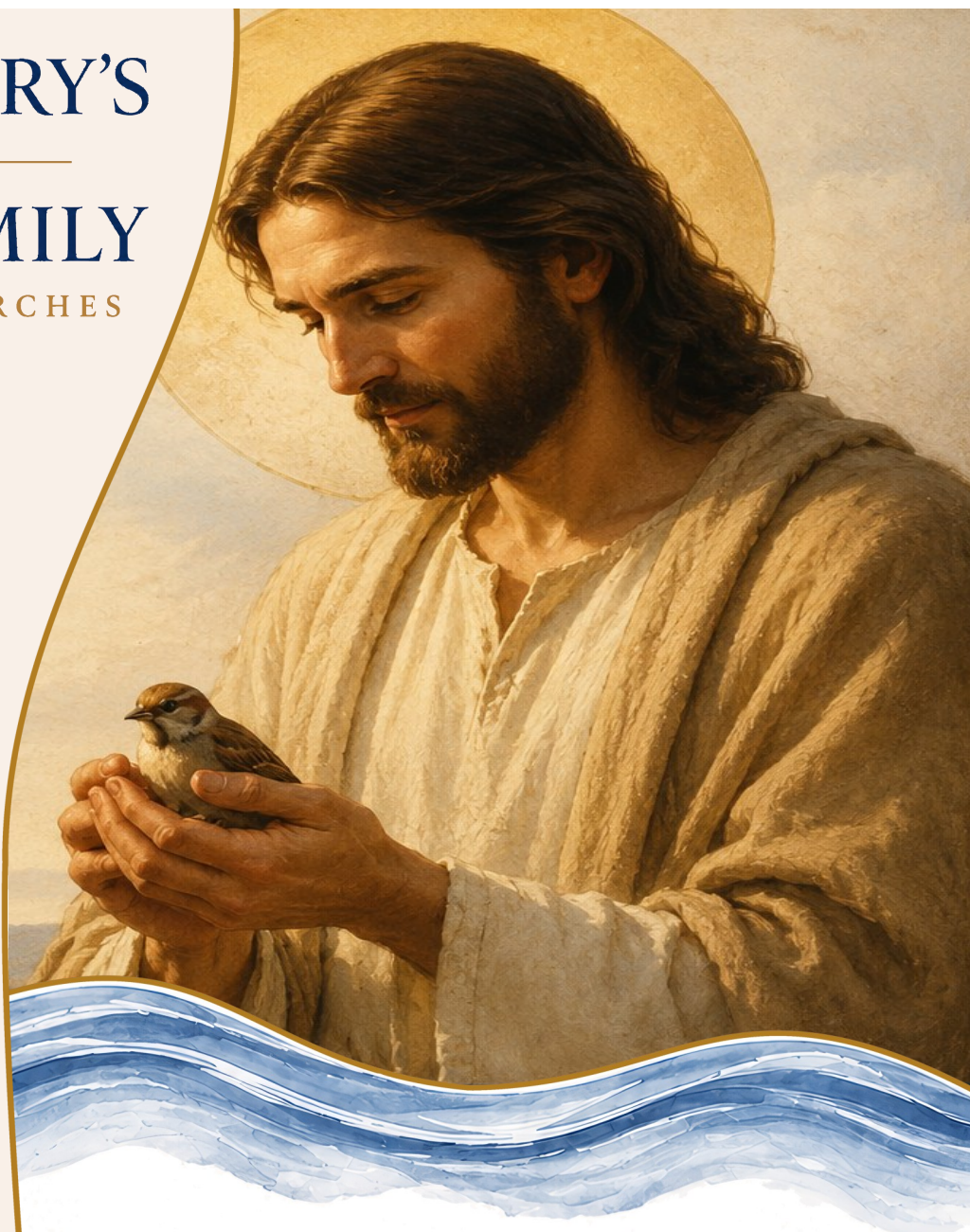

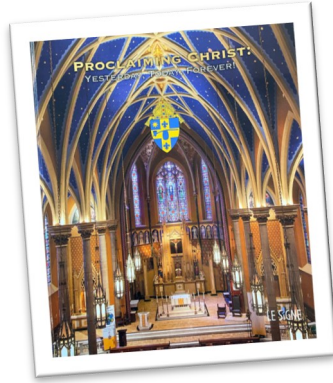
# NEWS & EVENTS
